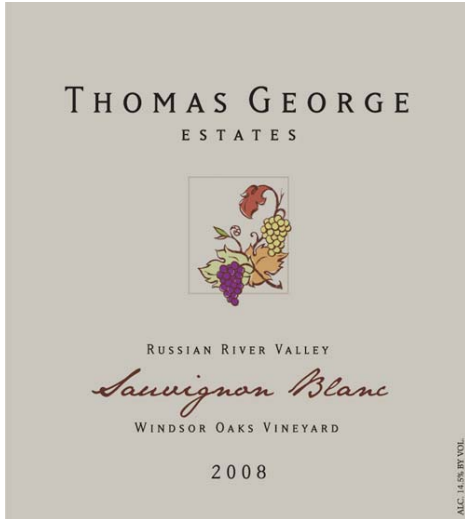

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**About the Wine:**

Our vineyard designate Sauvignon Blanc is from the Windsor Oaks Vineyard, located in the foothills lining the eastern edge of the Russian River Valley. These clone 1 vines on 101-14 rootstock are on a VSP trellis system in a north-south direction on a west facing slope. This was the first fruit we received for our 2008 vintage.

Hand harvested on Aug. 22, this Sauvignon Blanc fruit was at a ripeness of 23.8 degrees brix. As we pressed to tank, we could already smell and taste the rich honey and pineapple characteristics that epitomize this wine. This wine was by far our longest fermenter of 2008, having eight and a half weeks to ferment dry.
